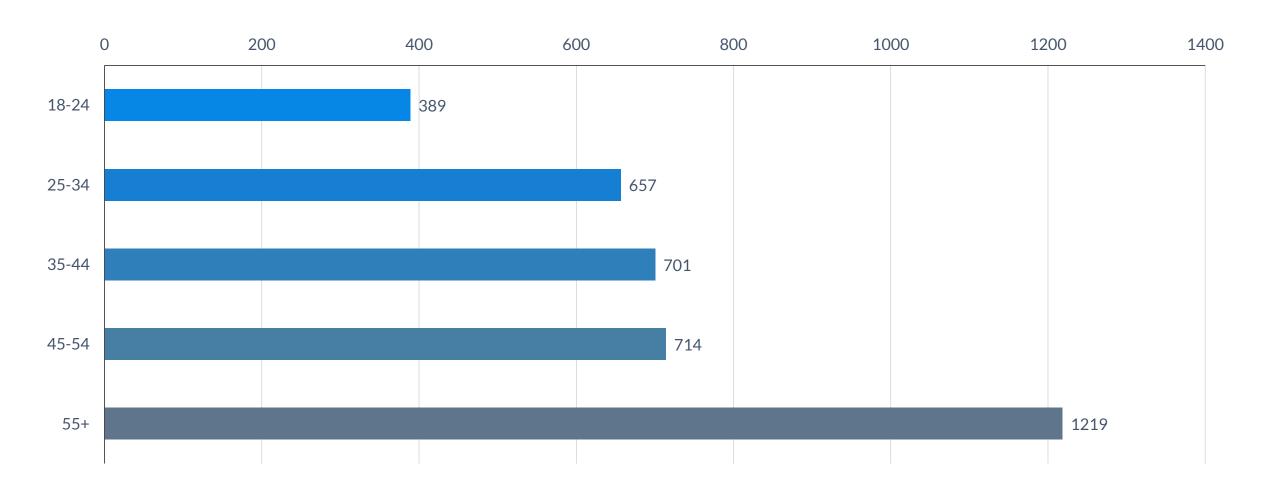

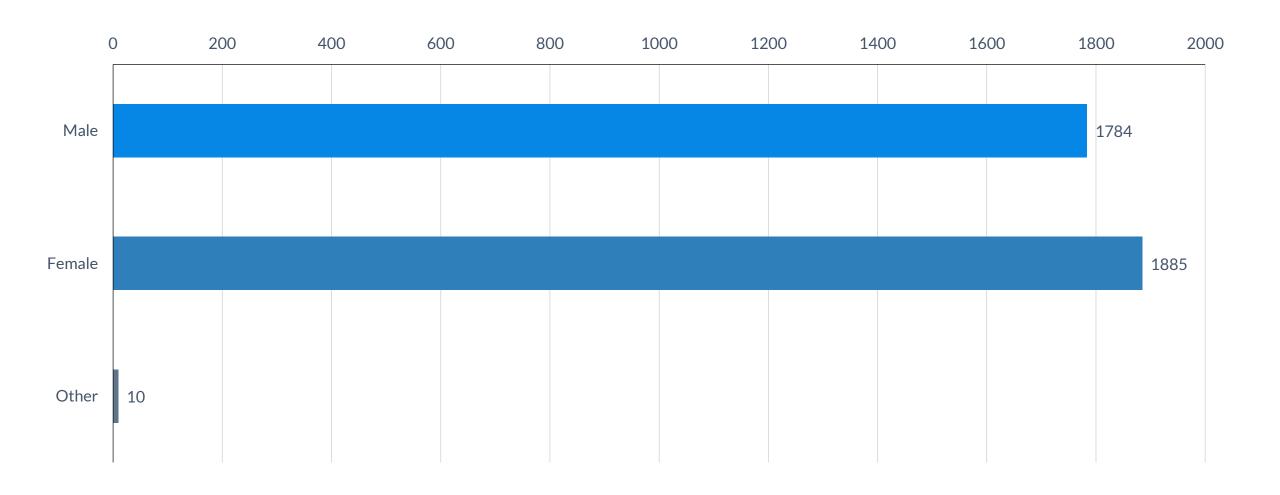

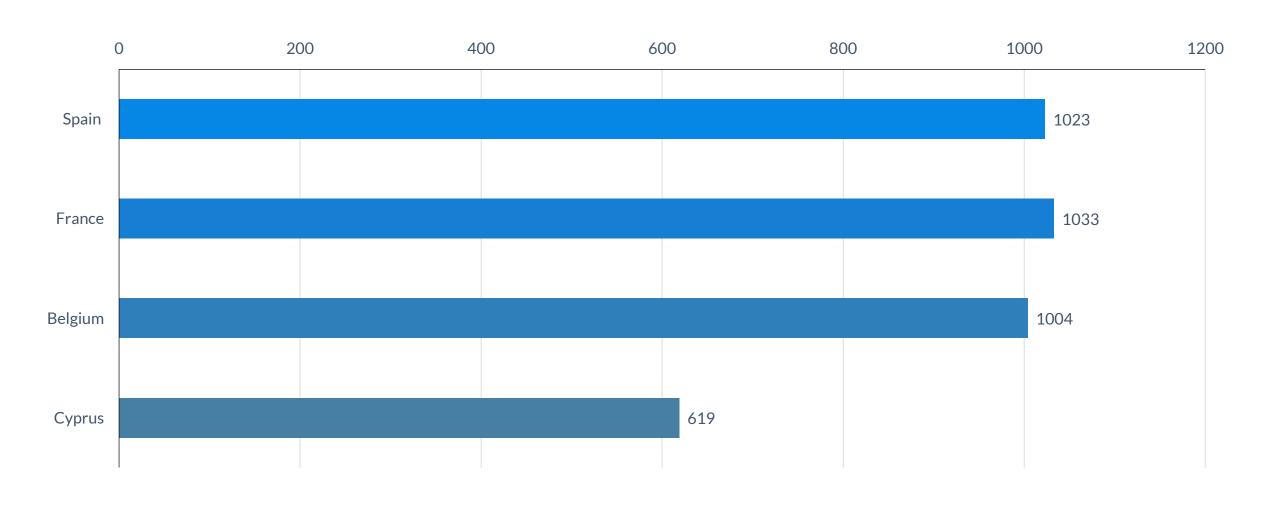

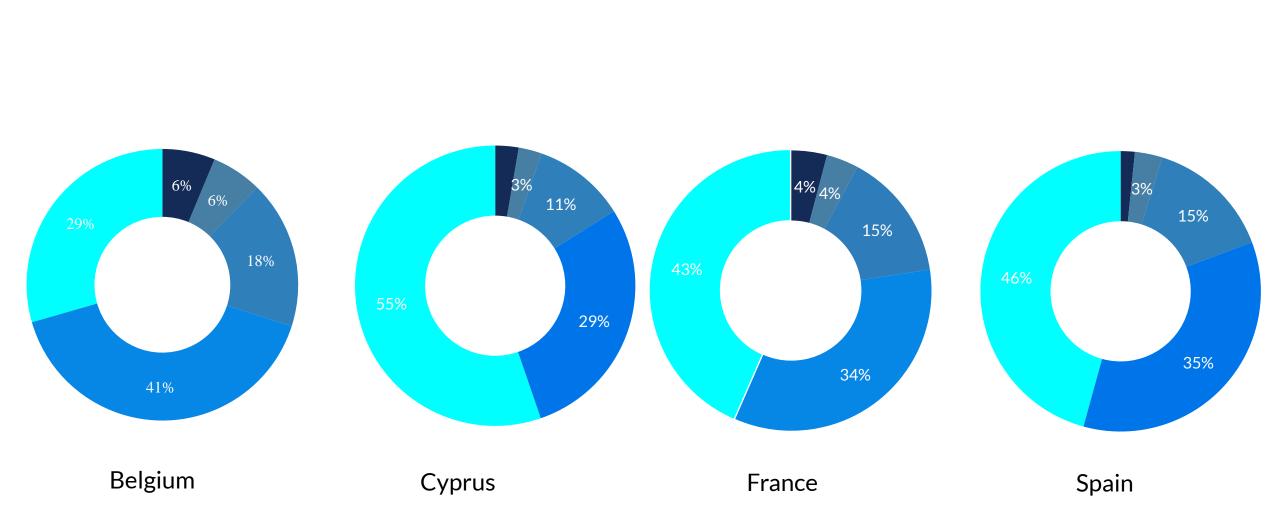

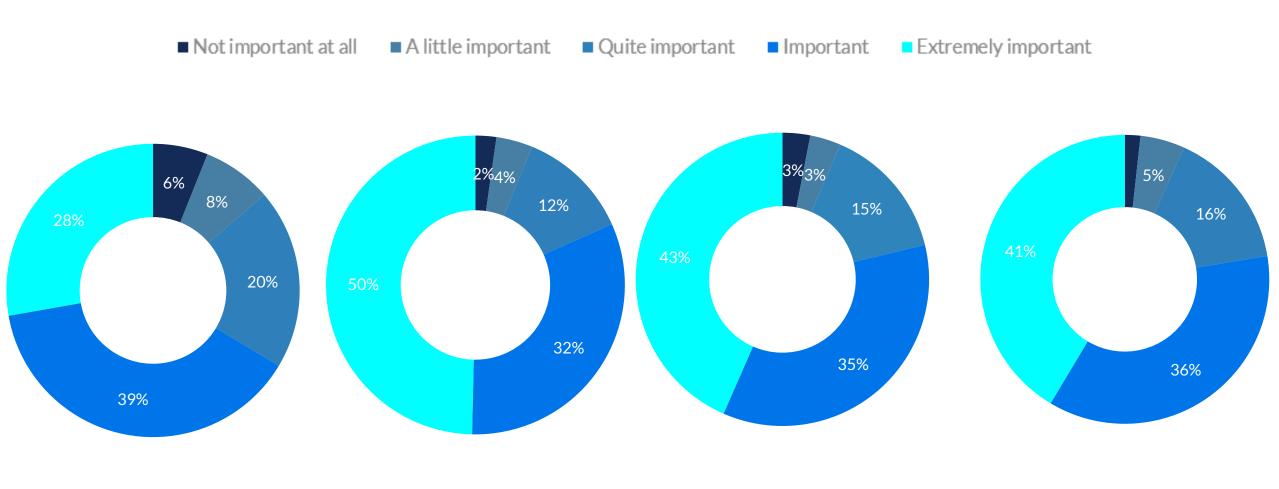

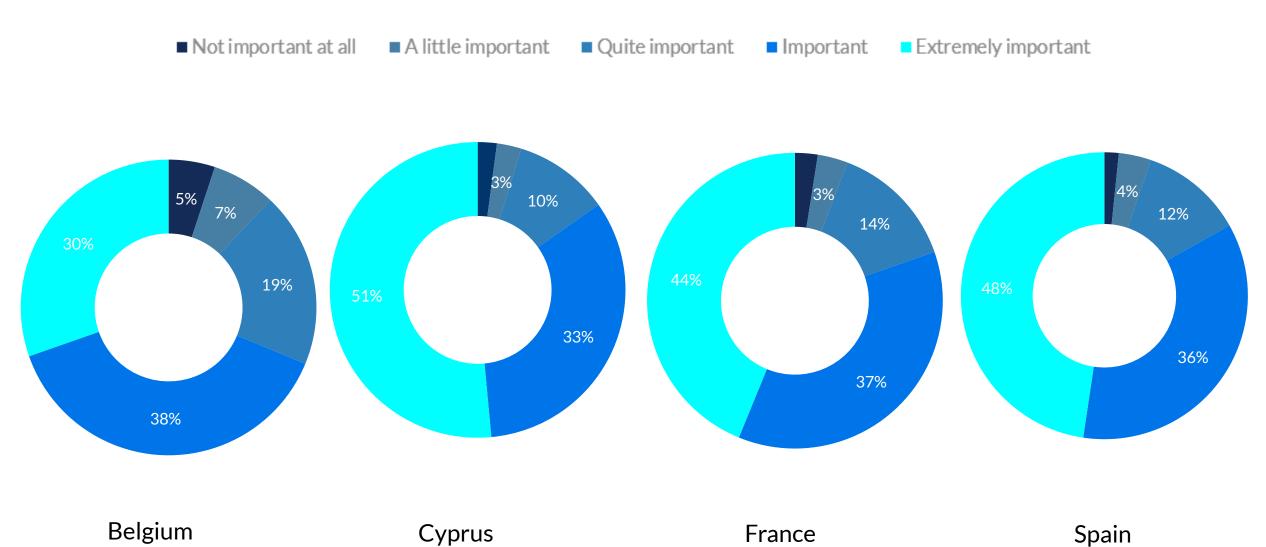


How important is it for you to have information on where processed fish products (such as tuna cans or fish fingers) were caught or produced?

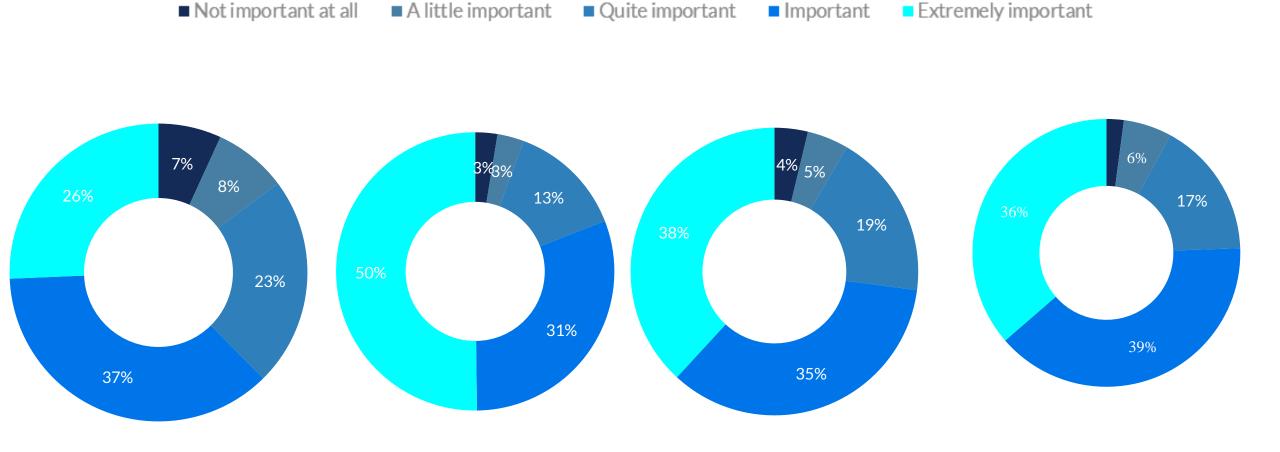

How important is it for you to have information about the fish species used in processed seafood products?



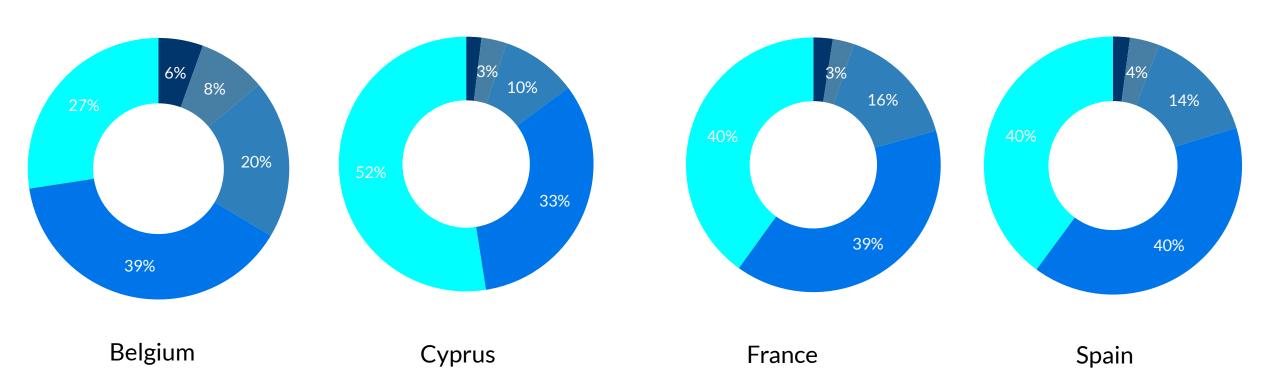

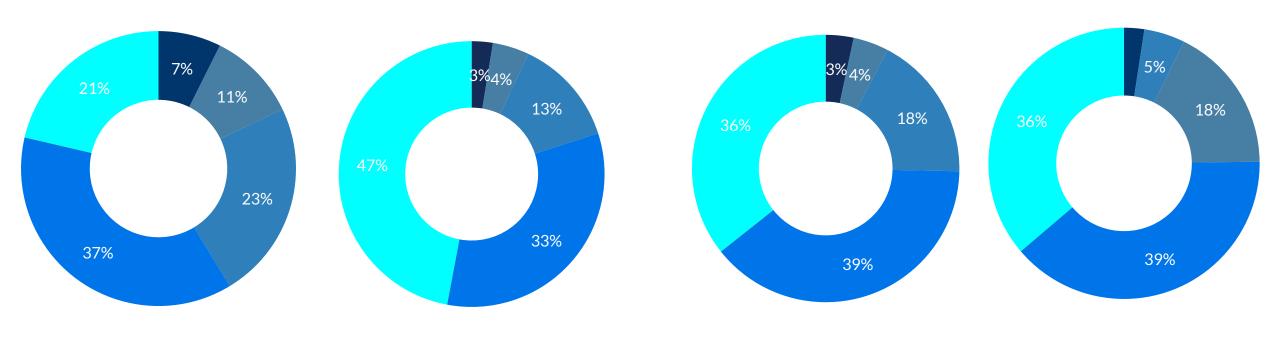

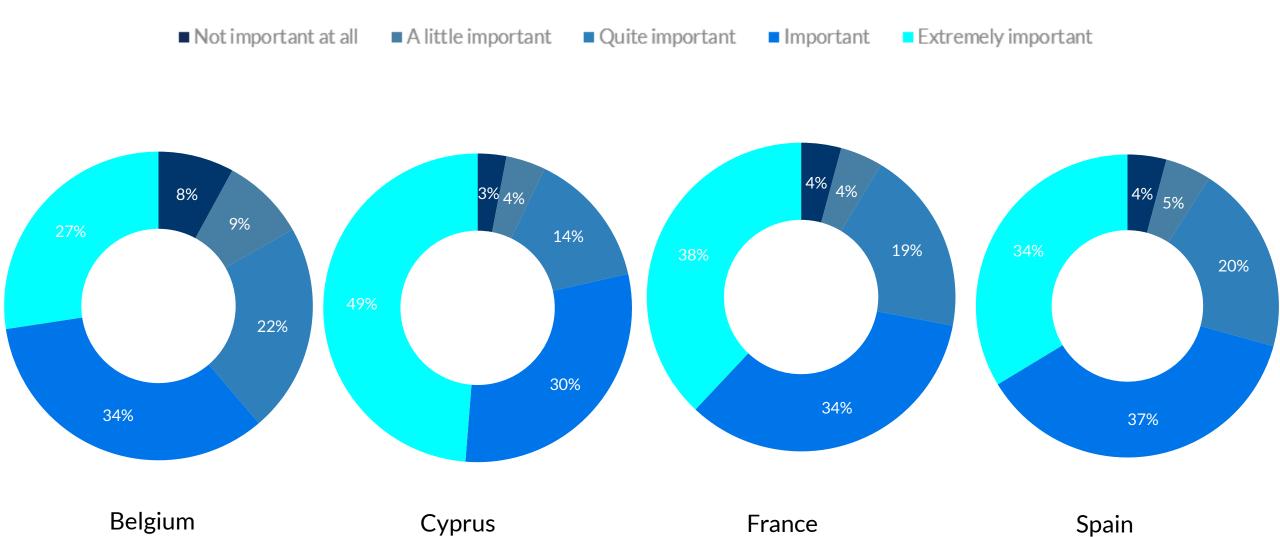
